Pensioner Rebate Policy

Responsible Officer: RATES OFFICER

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1. PURPOSE

To provide guidance to staff in applying the provisions of the Local Government Act (NSW) 1993 for rate and charges rebates applicable to eligible pensioners.

2. SCOPE

This policy is applicable to eligible pensioners as defined in Clause 134 of the Local Government (General) Regulations 2005.

3. DEFINITIONS

Pensioner	An eligible pensioner as defined in Clause 134 of the Local Government (General) Regulations 2005.		
Principal Place of Residence	The property which the ratepayer occupies as their sole or dominant residence.		
Ratepayer	The person liable for payment of Rates and Charges for the property in accordance with section 560 of the Act.		
Rates and Charges	Ordinary Rates and Annual Charges levied in accordance with the Act.		

4. OBJECTIVES

To provide eligible pensioners with the statutory pensioner concession relating to rates and charges under the provisions of section 575 of the "Act".

5. POLICY

Ratepayers who hold a current pensioner concession card and are solely or jointly liable for the rates and charges levied on land on which a dwelling which is their principal place of living is situated, may be eligible for a reduction in rates and charges according to section 575 of the Act.

The statutory reduction provided is fifty percent of the total ordinary rates and charges up to a maximum of \$250.00 on rates and \$87.50 each on water and sewer charges annually. If the ratepayer is jointly liable with other persons who are not eligible pensioners, the reduction will be proportionate to which the ratepayer is liable for the rates and charges.

If a ratepayer is eligible for a reduction on the date of the levy of the rates and charges notice, they are entitled to receive the annual amount. If they become eligible during the year, the following applies:

- Becomes eligible after levy date but before 1 October, 75% rebate;
- Becomes eligible between 1 October and 31 December (inclusive) 50% rebate;
- Becomes eligible between 1 January and 31 March (inclusive) 25% rebate;
- Becomes eligible between 1 April and 30 June (inclusive) no rebate.

Council will apply the rebate for the current financial year and one year prior.

Requests for reductions for eligible pensioners must be made on the Council's standard form (Annexure 1). A copy of the eligible pensioners pension card must be retained.

Section 581 of the Act enables Council to receive a Pensioner Concession Subsidy of 55% of all concessions granted for a rating year. Council funds the balance of 45% of pensioner concessions granted. Council is required to submit an Independent Audit Certificate to the Department of Local Government when applying for payment of the Pensioner Concession Subsidy.

6. ACCOUNTABILITIES

The Rates Officer is responsible for assessing applications against Part 8 Division 1 of the Act to determine whether the applicant is eligible for a rebate and the applicable amount. Council will check with Centrelink at least annually for verification of current pensioner eligibility.

Additional Information:

Your council will determine your eligibility to receive a rebate of up to \$250 on your rates account. You may also be eligible to receive up to \$87.50 on your annual water charges and up to \$87.50 off your annual sewerage charges, if your council provides these services.

Eligibility:

- · Holders of the PCC (Pensioner Concession Card);
- · Holders of a gold card embossed with 'TPI' (Totally Permanently Incapacitated);
- · Holders of a gold card embossed with 'EDA' (Extreme Disablement Adjustment);
- War widow or widower or wholly dependent partner entitled to the Pensioner Concession Card*.

^{*} If you are a war widow or widower or wholly dependent partner but do not have a Pensioner Concession Card, you should contact the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) to test your eligibility for the DVA income support supplement. Eligibility is subject to an income and assets test. Holders of cards other than those listed above are not eligible for the concession. For assistance from the DVA call 133 254.
