Purpose

To inform Council of completed and ongoing Engineering Works for the period of March 2014.

Background

March 2014 Engineering Works have consisted mainly of maintenance and some construction works on Shire Roads.

Shire Roads/Regional Roads

Roads to Recovery

- SR9 Neckarbo Road Road reconstruction in floodway causeway constructed;
- MR7518 RMS Repair project Road construction underway gravel carting ongoing;
- SR7- Mt Gap Road causeway construction completed;
- SR26- Wilga Downs Road gravel stockpiled by dozer, causeway being constructed.

Special Rate Variation Works

• SR 44 – Old Reservoir Road – formation grade.

Maintenance Work

- MR7518 Maintenance grading;
- MR7522- Maintenance grading;
- MR416 The Wool Track pot holing;
- SR20 The Grain Road –maintenance grading;
- SR26 Maintenance grading;
- SR21 Tallebung Road maintenance grading;

State Highways

Water and Sewer

Maintenance Work

- Continuation of Sewer Pump Station inspections and Flow Meter Recording Works;
- Pest control within Sewer Reticulation Network;
- Stop valve and hydrant repairs on town water supply reticulation ongoing;
- Clearing vegetation on the Nyngan to Cobar Pipeline easement (CWB) progressing;
- Scour valve flushing on 300mm pipeline (CWB) (Winter activity);
- Major meter reading works (CWB) ongoing;
- The pump used for Nymagee water supply malfunctioned and had to be replaced temporarily and a new pump has been installed and a backup has been ordered:
- Town water audit commenced 31.03.2014;
- Nyngan pump stations pump and electric motor has been sent for repairs;
- Adjustments made to the current water restrictions for Nymagee. These adjustments become enforceable as of Thursday 27 March 2014.
