**Note:**

Application is made for a Swimming Pool Compliance Certificate under section 22D of the *Swimming Pools Act 1992*, in relation to the compliance of the swimming pool identified above.

The owner of any premises on which a swimming pool is situated may apply to the local authority for a certificate of compliance with respect to the swimming pool.

If satisfied that the swimming pool complies with the requirements of this Part, the local authority must issue to the applicant a certificate to the effect that, as at the date on which it is issued, the swimming pool complies with those requirements. A certificate of compliance remains valid for a period of 3 years from the date on which it is issued but ceases to be valid if a direction is issued under section 23 in respect of the swimming pool to which the certificate relates.

The local authority that issues a certificate of compliance in respect of a swimming pool must ensure that details of the certificate are entered on the Swimming Pool Register.

For the purposes only of any appeal proceeding arising in connection with an application under this section, the local authority is taken to have refused the application if it has not finally determined the application within 6 weeks after the application was made.
